
Itinerary

Activity

- Explore Ann Siang Hill: Take a stroll up Ann Siang Hill, a charming street that's home to a variety of cafes, bars, and boutiques. Check out stylish shops, or grab a takeaway coffee at the Maxi Coffee Bar (own cost).
- Visit Buddha Tooth Relic Temple and Museum: Head to the Buddha Tooth Relic Temple and Museum, a stunning temple that's known for its intricate architecture and rich history. Learn about the Buddhist culture and tradition and admire the temple's ornate decorations.
- Explore Little India: After Chinatown, make your way to Little India, a vibrant neighborhood that's known for its colorful shops, traditional Indian food, and lively atmosphere. We head to Tekka Centre, a bustling hawker center that's known for its delicious Indian food. Try some local delicacies!
- Explore Serangoon Road: Take a stroll down Serangoon Road, a vibrant street that's lined with traditional Indian shops and restaurants. Visit boutiques such as Jothi Store and Flower Shop and marvel at the facade of the former house of Tan Teng Niah, the last surviving Chinese villa in Little India and a relic of the 1900s.
- We then make our way to Kampong Glam, the historic Malay quarter of Singapore! As we explore the vibrant streets and colorful shophouses of this charming neighborhood, we'll sample some of the best Malay cuisine the city has to offer. From fragrant Nasi Lemak to spicy Mee Siam, we'll savor the flavors of traditional Malay dishes at local eateries, and learn about the culture and history of the Malay community in Singapore. Don't miss this opportunity to indulge in the delicious food and rich heritage of Kampong Glam!
- We then end off the tour at Haji lane, in heart of the Arab Quarter, where you have the option to enjoy a fusion of local and Western cuisine with live music performances.
