







Sustainable Singapore Stories (Walking Tour)

Summary

Discover Singapore's efforts in sustainability through its years of economic growth. What you're in for:

- Learn about efforts in sustainability made by the Singapore government as well as the private sector
- Discover plants and herbs and enjoy a panoramic view of the city
- Explore the iconic Gardens by the Bay

Learn about Singapore's sustainable journey, as well as the efforts made by the government and the private sector to transform the city nation into one of the world's most sustainable cities.

Start by visiting a biophilic skyscraper in the central business district, where we will explore a sky garden perched over 50 stories high. Learn about the plants and herbs that are commonly used by local residents in food or as medicine, while overlooking Singapore's only reservoir in the heart of the city. Then take a scenic walk along Marina Bay and check out a favourite hangout spot with the locals at the Marina Barrage. Finally, step into another world that is the Gardens by the Bay — a self-sufficient ecosystem that has so much more life than meets the eye!

Do not miss this opportunity to discover Singapore's journey with sustainability and its efforts to become one of the most sustainable cities in Asia.

Itinerary

We begin the tour at Capital Spring – your knowledgeable guide will share with you about the 51st storey biophilic skyscraper in the Central Business District which also houses Singapore's largest observatory deck.

We then take the MRT to the Marina Barrage, Singapore's 15th reservoir, located in the heart of the city. Marina Barrage is built on the vision of the late Mr Lee Kuan Yew, Singapore's first Prime Minister and has a catchment area of 10,000 hectares. The view from here is stunning! Guide will share briefly on the Sustainable Singapore Gallery, an interactive gallery that showcases the multitude of areas of Singapore's sustainable development.

We'll then take a stroll across to the Gardens by the Bay, arguably Singapore's top attraction! You'll see why the minute you hop off and enter a wondrous world unlike any other. The Gardens are famous for their Super Trees, which are embedded with environmentally sustainable functions. Your guide will share the Lake System which comprises of two lakes – the Dragonfly Lake and Kingfisher Lake. The Gardens lake system incorporates key ecological processes and functions as a living system.

Finally, you'll be dropped off at the architecturally distinctive Conservatories to explore at your own leisure (entrance cost at own expenses). Comprising two glass biomes, the Conservatories replicate the cool-dry climate of the Mediterranean and semi-arid sub-tropical regions and the cool-moist climate of the Tropical Montane region.
